

## Peoria Area EMS/ OSF ST. Francis Medical Paramedic Program



Registration Form

This Paramedic course is offered to those who are currently EMT-B or EMT-I licensed providers in Illinois. This course is conducted in accordance with NREMT standards and is approved by IDPH and PAEMS system. PAEMS has been issued a letter of review from the *Committee on Accreditation of Educational Programs for EMS Professions* (CoAEMSP). This letter is not a CAAHEP accreditation status, it is a status signifying that the program is seeking its initial accreditation and has demonstrated sufficient compliance with the accreditation standards through the Letter of Self Study Report (LSSR) and other documentation. This LoR is recognized by the NREMT for eligibility to take the NREMT Paramedic credentialing exams to acquire an NREMT license.

**Requirements:** The applicant must have verification of at least 1 year work experience as an EMT-B or I, a current and valid AHA Healthcare Provider CPR card, proof of a physical exam (within 1 year), current vaccination records- which may require additional vaccines as necessary, current Tuberculosis test, & a clean felony record.

**Course Information:** This course curriculum has both online and classroom (Lab) activities. PAEMS utilizes **PlatinumED & JB Learning** software that tracks the student's progress throughout the course by documenting all assignments, skills, quizzes, high stakes exams, & patient contacts which is verified by the instructor. The student will be required to have their own computer, laptop, tablet, or other electronic device along with access to the internet. The student must utilize their initiative in progressing through this course at the defined pace. In classroom (Lab) sessions will be held 1 day per week (Fridays) from 8am-4:30pm which gives the student ample opportunity to complete all online activities.

**Registration Information:** Course fee-\$6,000 which includes access to the online software and textbooks. This also includes ACLS, PALS, and ITLS courses-textbooks-& certificates, along with background check and drug screening. Deadline for registering is 14 days prior to the start of class.

<u>Course dates:</u> Fridays only from August 7, 2020 through April 23, 2021 8:00am-4:30pm. The student will then have 6 months to complete all field internship requirements to be eligible to sit for the NREMT examinations.
