Please be aware that there have been occasional medication shortages. Most recently there has been a shortage of Hypertonic Saline and Creon 36,000. If possible, try to refill medications before you are completely out so we can assist in changing medication or locating a pharmacy that may be able to fill your prescription. Thanks!

The DCC is NOT part of your official medical record. It's a tool to help us, your care team, check in with each other and follow up with you.

What to expect when we use the Daily Care Check-In during a clinic appointment?

~ All people with Cystic Fibrosis 12 and older will have the opportunity to use the Daily Care Check-In. It's YOUR CHOICE to fill it out and every question is optional. This will be done once per year.

~There are 18 questions about things that can get in the way of doing treatments. It takes 3-5 minutes for you to complete the form.

New Process at Clinic Visits

To support you in balancing your health needs with daily life, we are using a new tool from the CF Foundation called the Daily Care Check-In (DCC). This new tool will ask you about what's going on in your life. Your responses will help us understand how we can help you maintain your daily care. The DCC is NOT about judging or grading you or telling you what to do. We know at times things may get in the way of doing treatments.
