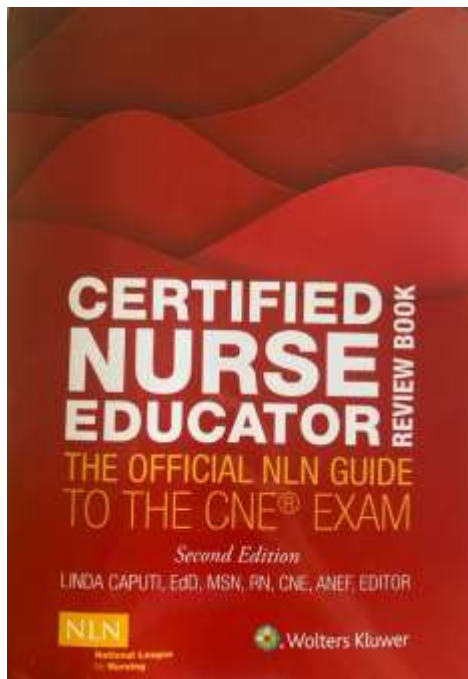
Registration and Payment
