Emergency Medical Responder
Hybrid EMR Course

Course Description

The Emergency Medical Responder (EMR) course is designed to provide highly trained individuals with the skills necessary to begin assessing and caring for patients at the scene of a medical and/or traumatic emergency. EMR's are often first on the scene and their prompt treatments and care rendered can save lives. Many local agencies utilize EMR's as a very important part of their emergency response. Once the student successfully completes this course they are eligible to receive an Illinois EMR License.

This is a hybrid course where the student will view lectures, participate in assigned activities, and take assigned quizzes & Tests online-on their own-outside of a classroom setting via the internet, and the student must attend skills practice on 3 Saturdays. This requires that the student has reliable access to the internet and a device to participate in such assignments.

Requirements

Students wishing to become an EMR must be 18 years of age or older by the end of course. The student must adhere to the guidelines of the PAEMS student handbook which may be found on our website OSFEMS.org. The student must have a current AHA Healthcare Provider CPR card through this course or prior to its completion. There are no hospital or field clinical requirements for this course.

Registration

Course fee is \$300. Registration fee includes Electronic textbook(s), online fees, and all other course materials. This registration form and payment must be turned in to PAEMS 2 weeks prior to class beginning. Upon completion of the class the student must pay for the IDPH initial license fee.

Cancellation Policy

There must be a minimum of 10 students registered to hold this course. If the course is cancelled by PAEMS all fees will be returned. If a student does not attend or cancels less than 24 hours prior to the first class they will forfeit their course fees.
