<sup>2</sup>General education core requirements may be met by:

- 1) Completion of each course as specified above.
  - 2) Completion of an Associate in Arts (AA), Associate in Science (AS), or Bachelor Degree from an approved, regionally accredited college or university
- A minimum of 64 semester credits is required before beginning the nursing program.
  - A student may apply for admission after completing: 32 prerequisite credits and at least one of the Nursing Sciences (Anatomy and Physiology, Chemistry, or Microbiology)
  - A student must earn a minimum 2.50 Cumulative GPA and 2.70 Nursing Science GPA (A & P, Chemistry, and Microbiology) on a 4.0 point scale. Nursing Sciences *must be less than 10 years old*.
