<sup>2</sup>General education core requirements may be met by:

- 1) Completion of each course as specified above; OR
- 2) Completion of a bachelor degree from an approved, regionally accredited college or university.
  - A minimum of 64 credits is required before beginning the nursing program.
  - All students must meet each of the Nursing Prerequisite requirements.
  - A student may apply for admission after completing: 32 prerequisite credits, at least one of the prerequisite nursing sciences, with a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and a nursing prerequisite science GPA (A&P, college chemistry and microbiology *must be less than 10 years old*) of at least 2.7 on a 4 point scale.
