



2020 McCarthy Family Scholarship

OSF HealthCare Saint Luke Medical Center is pleased to offer the McCarthy Family Scholarship for students pursuing a Registered Nurse (RN, BSN) designation. The scholarship is in honor of Miss Harriet McCarthy and her parents, Harry and Florence B. McCarthy. Miss McCarthy was a mathematics instructor at Kewanee High School for 38 years, retiring in 1971. Mr. McCarthy was a products engineer for the Walworth Company in Kewanee in the early 1900s. Their family was an integral part of the Kewanee community for many years. OSF Saint Luke honors their lasting citizenship and their commitment to higher learning through this McCarthy Family Scholarship opportunity.

General Information

One McCarthy Family Scholarship recipient will be chosen annually. The maximum scholarship award is \$8,000, payable over the course of the recipient's education until their RN, BSN designation is obtained. \$1000 will be awarded for each semester of full-time coursework.

Applications are due to OSF Saint Luke Medical Center attn: Stephanie Hilten, OSF Foundation no later than 4:00 p.m. on Monday, August 31, 2020.

An application form is attached. The scholarship recipient will be notified of his/her award by Tuesday, September 15, 2020.

The McCarthy Family Scholarship is open to anyone with a primary residence in Henry, Stark, or Bureau Counties who is enrolled in an accredited Nursing program, either at an associates, diploma, or bachelors degree level (potentially 2, 3 and 4 years of study respectively.)

Each scholarship recipient will be required to work for OSF HealthCare for a minimum length of time following completion of his or her RN, BSN program. The length of this commitment would correlate with the amount of assistance received. (i.e. Two semesters of assistance at \$1,000 per semester would result in two years of work for OSF HealthCare.) Scholarship recipients will review and sign a student loan promissory note and student loan disclosure statement, which contain details of the program.

The McCarthy Family Scholarship Selection Committee consists of the OSF Saint Luke Community Relations Coordinator, Vice President/Chief Nursing Officer at OSF Saint Luke, a member of the educational community and one community member selected at large.
