Required Immunizations

- MMR (Measles, Mumps, Rubella)
- Flu (Annual)
- TDap (Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis)
- Chicken Pox (Varicella)



Illnesses

- Do **not** come to volunteer if ill. Especially if vomiting, diarrhea, or fever in **last 24 hrs.**
- We do not treat personal illnesses, we will refer you to PCP (primary care provider).
- A provider's release or a note from Employee/Occupational Health is required after a volunteer has been off work for **3 or more consecutive work days.**

Work-Related Injuries

- All work related injuries, including exposures, or anything that happens when volunteering that could or did result in an injury.
- Must let your Supervisor know in the area you are volunteering immediately. You will be sent to Occupational Health if it is during the day M-F or to Emergency Room if it is nighttime or on the weekends.
- Need to fill out a Verge report ASAP!

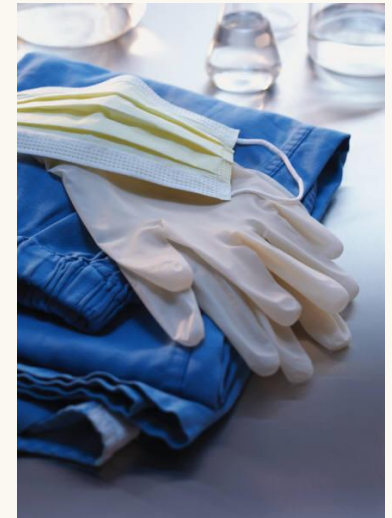
How Infection is Transmitted

- Needle Sticks & Sharps
 - Hollow-bore needles
 - Solid Sharp (suture needle, scalpel)
- Body Fluid Transmission
 - Splash Exposure
 - Mucous Membrane Contact
 - Open Wound



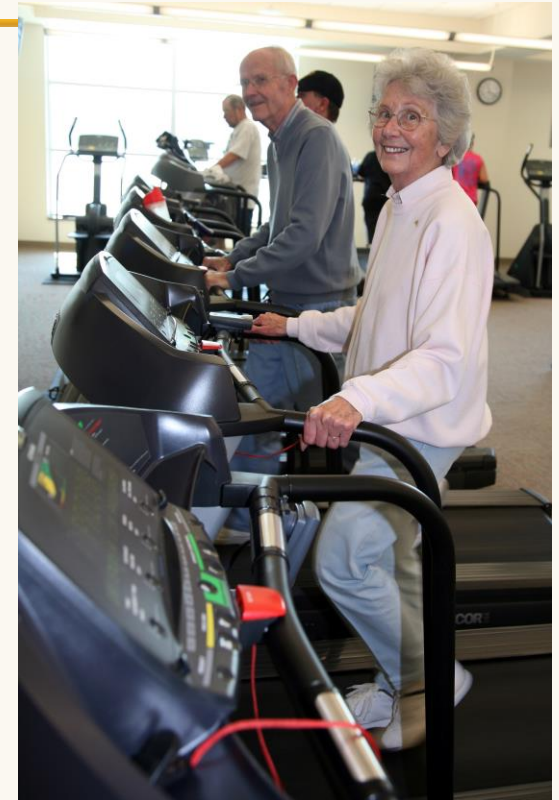
Standard Precautions

- Hand washing- with soap and water
- Personal Protective Equipment (PPE's)
 - Gloves
 - Mask
 - Gown
 - Face Shield or Goggles
 - Other Items As Needed
- Proper Handling and Disposing of Used Patient Materials
