Those of you with Meridian insurance should have received a letter stating that OSF is no longer in network

If you would like to continue receiving long term covered care and services through OSF after December 14, you will need to choose a different managed care Medicaid Plan.

We encourage you to contact other managed care programs to see what is best covered for your child. We do participate in Illinicare and Molina Medicaid managed care plans.

DEXCOM AND LIBRE USERS

Please let front desk staff know if you have started your Dexcom or Libre at home. We need to make sure we have the correct information you used to set up the Dexcom/Libre, so we can enter it into our system, to download your Dexcom or Libre when you come to your appointment. This is especially important for Libre users who use their phone to scan blood sugars
