**Course Description**

The Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) course is designed to provide highly trained individuals with the skills necessary to provide basic life support, airway support and cardiac care, and administer lifesaving medications at the scene of a medical and/or traumatic emergency.

EMT's are on the front line of many medical and traumatic emergencies. This course is taught in accordance with the National Standard Curriculum set forth by NAEMT & NHTSA. Once the student successfully completes this course they are eligible to challenge the national exam.

*This is a hybrid course where the student will view lectures, participate in assigned activities, and take assigned quizzes and tests online-on their own-outside of a classroom setting via the internet and attend skills practice on Tuesday evenings. This requires that the student has reliable access to the internet and a device to participate in such assignments. The first class will be orientation and instruction on participating in the online portion of this course.*

**Requirements**

Students wishing to become an EMT must be 18 years of age or older by the end of course & possess a HS diploma or GED. The student must adhere to the guidelines of the PAEMS student handbook which may be found on our website OSFEMS.org.

**Registration**

Course fee is \$850. Registration fee includes textbook(s), fees, and all other course materials. This registration form and payment must be turned in to PAEMS 2 weeks prior to class beginning. All other IDPH licensing fees are the responsibility of the student.

**Cancellation Policy**

There must be a minimum number of students registered to hold this course. If the course is cancelled by PAEMS all fees will be returned. If the student does not attend or cancels less than 24 hours prior to the first class they forfeit their course fees.
